Important Notice - Noxious Weed Alert

I hope this message finds you well. I am writing to bring to your attention a concerning issue that has been noticed our community recently – the presence of a noxious weed in our area. As responsible homeowners, it is essential that we take collective action to address this problem and ensure the health and beauty of our neighborhood.

The weed in question is Canada Thistle, and it has been identified in various locations throughout our community. It grows in circular patches, spreading up to 10-12 feet in one season. It spreads quickly by rhizome and seed production.



Noxious weeds can spread rapidly and have a detrimental impact on the local environment and property values. They can compete with native plants, disrupt local ecosystems, and even pose health risks to pets and humans. It's crucial that we take prompt action to prevent the further spread of this weed.

What Can We Do?

We recommend using 2,4-D Amine Selective Weed Killer to treat Canada Thistle. This professional-quality herbicide is easy to use and is selective so it will only target the problem weed and leave your desired plants unharmed. Other remedies may be found on the internet by looking up Canada Thistle
